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Description of the discipline

"Banking Law" is a discipline that contributes to the training of legal professionals, mastering the system of norms of the Banking Law of Ukraine and current banking legislation. Students acquire theoretical knowledge of the basic concepts and institutions of Banking Law (foreign banks, banking relations, subjects of banking relations, banking agreements, banking offenses, liability for violation of banking legislation, banking services, the system of bank guarantees, etc: 1) independent study and use of banking legislation and literature on banking law; 2) independent solution of problems arising in the process of applying banking legislation; 3) development of legal documents used in practical banking activities (banking agreements, banking projects, etc.).

Upon completion of the discipline "Banking Law", students can reasonably interpret the current banking legislation and correctly apply it in solving practical problems, arguing their own point of view on the decision made; timely identify problems of legal regulation of banking legal relations and, guided by the norms of the current legislation of Ukraine, resolve issues of protection of the rights of subjects of banking legal relations.
