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Description of the discipline

Discipline “Global studies” aimed at forming students' understanding of globalization as a concept, methodology, an integral component of the historical process and a specific period of human development, the ability to use the concept of globalization to explain and interpret historical events and current trends in world development; assimilation of systematic theoretical and practical knowledge of global studies, methods, methods and tools of global analysis, trends in the development of the world economy, socio-cultural sphere, understanding of the essence of global environmental problems.
